NOTIFICATION

No. F.5-14/2019-B&A/DRAP.-- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 20 of the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan Act, 2012 (XXI of 2012) read with clause (n) and clause (x) of section 7 and clause (d) of section 11 thereof, the Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan, with the approval of the Policy Board, is pleased to specify the following cost recovery mechanism in respect of out-station inspections carried out by the Authority, namely:-

- (i) Charges incurred on travelling and daily allowance shall be borne by the concerned company or firm for all out-station inspection;
- (ii) Inspection panel shall consist of a maximum of three members;
- (iii) Members of the board/committee and any expert (if nominated) will be paid travelling and daily allowance as admissible to an officer in BPS-20 while the officers of the Authority will be paid as per their entitlements;
- (iv) Members of the inspection panel will be entitled to economy class air-tickets, if required, to be provided by the company(ies) or firm(s);
- (v) The company(ies) or firm(s) will submit request to Budget & Accounts Division through concerned Division(s) of the Authority at least seven working days prior to inspection for calculation of estimated costs of travelling and daily allowance expenses as per paragraph (iii) and submit the original bank deposit slip after depositing the amount so calculated;
- (vi) If there are more than one company or firm to be inspected by panel at a station, the expenses may be distributed among them by mutual consent.
